25/23-24	Des Read, Chairman of Victoria Park Residents Association (VPRA) presented the latest newsletter. Invites have been issued for a meeting between representatives of the Ministry of Justice (MoJ) Wessex Water, Wiltshire Council, the Environment Agency and the VPRA due to take place on 9 th June 2023. The trackway has been removed from the village green. Following independent enquiries, the MoJ issued a statement confirming lack of authority to utilise the Village Green for site equipment and confirming the forthcoming removal of the equipment and re-instatement of the Village Green. The Ministry of Justice will need to re-determine access to the site for removal of the cabins in the absence of trackway, and what options exist for access for residents, commercial and emergency vehicles when pre-adoption works resume. The VPR AGM would be on 4 th July 7pm at the New Pavilion and a formal invite to the Parish Council will follow.
