


Newton Toney Groundwater Level 2023-24



Groundwater Report w/b 18-Mar-2024

The groundwater remains high but has continued to fall from last week and is now 8" or 21 cm below ground level. The Bourne is flowing strongly and has also fallen a little over the week. Sumps have been switched off now. Groundwater levels at the 3 nearest stations are all falling. News from the Met Office: The South of England "experiencing its wettest February since the series began in 1836..The UK's 10 warmest Februaries on record in a series from 1884 now include 2024, 2023, 2022 and 2019."
