## Plans for improving the hall/ facilities

As with all grade one listed buildings maintenance is our biggest expenditure. Some of the electric heaters have failed and we are in the process of getting quotes which may involve changing all the heaters in the hall, not cheap!

We're working on a program of redecoration, one big job each year. We've done the floors, decorated the Main hall, corridor and machin room, this year we plan to paint outside, next year the ancillary rooms.

It's my aim to do a big fundraiser perhaps next year, to refurbish the kitchen cupboards and worktops.

The largest long term issue we have is that at sometime in the past concrete patches have been used to cover failing bricks. These are now failing themselves and need taking off, new bricks inserting and the whole building repointing. Example.

We know that the roof is generally sound but the piece over this building which was not replaced when the upgrade was done, and has needed some repairs this year.

### Marketing plans

With out the ballet school marketing has become much more important. We (Cat and Clare) continue to advertise on facebook locally, sites that advertise village halls for hire more widely and using posters around the villages. We are also considering perhaps going to a wedding fair to try and attract DIY couples on a small budget.
